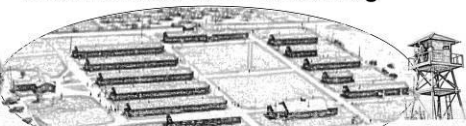

## **Treasurer's Report**

Current balance - \$2,115.64.

St. Paul Lutheran Church and School donated \$150 in honor of the time Ed Evans helped at their school; the money is to be used for CCC/POW camp needs. We also received a \$15 membership fee.

## **Bike Donation and Raffle – Nick Kramer spoke on behalf of the Lion's Club**

Sugar Bike Shop in Spencerport is willing to donate a Beach Cruiser bike, retail value \$300, to be used as a fund raiser. The group approved spending \$110 to have 1,000 tickets printed. Ticket charges are \$2/ticket or \$5/3 tickets. Tickets may be sold through Lions Club, Friends members, Health Fair in Sweden Center (March 22), Earth Day, Wheel Fest, and I Love My Park Day. - Salvation Army buildings at Troutburg may be available soon but they would need to be moved to a non-park location. Current consensus is they will not be able to be used in the park since their historical significance has not been approved.

- Joanne Sharp (from a CCC camp in Virginia) will be publishing info about Terpin Rock. Ed has been communicating with CCC affiliated groups in several states.
