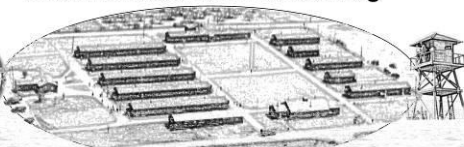

Ed's Updates

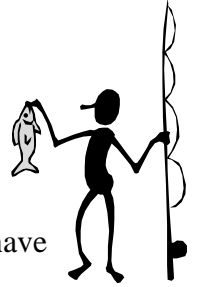
- Ed's crew created a 96' x 3' x 2.5' foot high wall using 36 tons of Medina sandstone that was moved from the CCC camp to a road near the kiosk. The CCC boys did similar work for \$1/day.
- In December three employees came from the NY Park's Albany office to look over the historical documents and artifacts. They are working on plans that need to be made in the house to make sure the house is climate controlled to protect the documents and artifacts.
- Friends' group members are welcome to stop and shovel the walkway and the area by the kiosk to make it more welcoming; there's a shovel on the porch. The solar panel by the flag pole should also be brushed off. Brush can be picked up at any time. All help is greatly appreciated.
- Ed has visited nine Albion middle school classes to teach them about the CCC/POW camp.
- Ed has completed 134 talks to date. Go Ed! He just received copies of 75 photos from a CCC camp in Tennessee.

- Linda created a brief write-up to be added to the Park's brochure.

Jay's Info

- The town is not having a free fishing day this year so the Park would like to sponsor this project. Jay would like our help in getting donations of poles, bait, etc. Jeanine will ask Paul at the next Conservation Board meeting to see if they have equipment we can borrow.
- July 6th – Fireworks will be twice as long as last year. Some ideas for the 4th of July theme: National Guard military equipment on display, a band, red/white/blue decorations, hot dog eating competition, baseball games. If possible we can look into getting little pies that we can give away for donations. If a company donates to us we are a 501c3 so they could write off the donations. We need someone to organize donations.
